VETERANS' DAY

When is Veterans Day? Veterans Day in 2010 is on Thursday, the 11th of November. In the United States, Veterans Day is usually observed on November 11.

The beginning of Veterans Day started when the first unofficial Veterans Day began with the end of World War 1 when the "armistice", or cessation of hostilities, between the Allied nations and Germany went into effect on the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month. For that reason, November 11, 1918, is generally regarded as the end of "the war to end all wars", and the original holiday was meant to celebrate the end of the "Great War" it's dead and survivors. Once known as Armistice Day the holiday is celebrated as "Remembrance Day" on or near November 11 in many countries other than the United States.
